

View My Degree Progress Report

A Degree Progress Report (DPR) is used for degree planning and advising. It compares the courses you've taken to the requirements for your degree and shows what you still need to graduate. By bringing all of your requirements; major, minor, core requirements, etc., together in one report, it is easier for you to plan and complete your academic goals.

1. To view your DPR sign in to your Student Center and click on the My Academics link.
